

The Lord Lieutenant of Northamptonshire has sent this to every parish and town council in Northamptonshire.

To mark and celebrate Her Majesty The Queen's Platinum Jubilee next year every Town and Parish Council in Northamptonshire is invited through The Queen's Green Canopy initiative to "Plant a Tree for the Jubilee" as part of a nationwide celebration.

The project will see all counties of the United Kingdom creating a network of individual or specimen trees, avenues, copses and woodlands in honour of The Queen's 70 years of service to the Nation. There is already great interest in this project across the county and whether your council plants a single specimen tree, a row of trees, an avenue or a copse the Platinum Jubilee will offer an opportunity for people to unite in celebration of The Queen's lifetime of service and encourage people to come together with the common purpose of "greening" their local environments.

In terms of timings the first planting phase will be from October 2021 to April 2022 and the Platinum Jubilee Official National Celebration Weekend is on the 3rd to the 6th of June 2022.

FARTHINGHOE VILLAGE HALL NEWS

Update: We are looking forward to opening fully in July (subject to Government confirmation). Regular hirers have been back for several weeks now and we hope to settle quickly into a new era. The outside area has proven to be an attraction for weddings and Marjorie Morris has been busy signing up a number of celebrations for the future.

Read and Feed: Our book loan facility will be in operation again shortly assuming Covid restrictions are lifted, and additional shelving is being installed to hold the growing number of Titles. Refreshments will be on offer again as before with a range of beverages and cakes available. The next event will be Friday 30th July at 14.00hrs.

Hall upgrades: Lisa has obtained a grant to have the Hot Water system upgraded and this will provide Hot water to all areas of the Hall without the need for individual heating elements on the walls. As part of this project we will be upgrading the Kitchen with a new floor, new units and an additional oven donated by Gary and Jane Mills. All pipework and electrical connections will be concealed rather than exposed on the walls as at present.

The storage area has been expanded into the roof area and a safety rail fitted to the first floor - thanks to John Lee for his help with this. The sheds have been prepared for new roofs to be fitted this summer.

Village Show: A reminder that the show will take place on Sunday 26th September with all produce from the gardening competitions going to the Church for Harvest Festival. The Morris Dancers have been secured for the event along with a number of local companies selling their wares. Following the success of the 2019 Show, there will be a BBQ and drinks served from the Bar with outside tables and chairs to create a relaxed atmosphere. Thanks to: Mike and Jenny Phipps for the fabulous rose arch and evolving gardens at the Hall. Also Jon Hampson for making the hedges look so smart, Keith Bullock for keeping the grass well trimmed and all the Committee for keeping things moving forward despite the Pandemic.

Dear Dave

I write on behalf of Brackiey Community Hospital 2020 Trust to acknowledge the donation of the sum of £500 from Farthinghoe Parish Council towards our fundraising efforts for equipment, for the new facility, that will be over and above the essential criteria for NHS provision but which will benefit the residents of Brackiey and the surrounding villages who will use the services at the new hospital.

We send sincere thanks to the chairman and members for this generous contribution, and for the ongoing support; additionally I would advise that the cost of this acknowledgement is not borne by the Trust. I am pleased to be able to report that we have reached our initial target to ensure that Brackley had a state-of-the-art digital x-ray machine with fixed table. In due course we will indeed have that extremely useful facility; some internal reconstruction work is required, however, so I am not yet sure when it will be up and running.

The figures made known to us by the Northamptonshire Healthcare Foundation Trust indicate that we already have some "overs", which will help with the acquisition of further specialised equipment that will ensure that consultants come to patients here rather than having patients travel to larger hospitals; this will make life easier for local residents and certainly help to reduce our carbon footprints. Items now on our "desirable" list include the ultrasound scanner together with equipment for cardiologists and ophthalmologists, enabling them to come to us and thus accommodate local people more easily and in a more welcoming environment. Additionally, we have agreed to fund some gym equipment for the physiotherapy department which will also enable group sessions to take place. This is a tremendous achievement by Individuals, organisations and companies within both Brackley and the surrounding villages who have supported our initiative so enthusiastically and so generously.

For internal audit purposes and adherent to the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) the donation will be privately recorded in our secure records as having been received in the name of Farthinghoe Parish Council. As a matter of compliance with the regulations a full explanation of our GDPR policy can be found at www.brackleycommunityhospital.charity.co.uk.

Again, thank you for this donation and please be assured that it will be put to best use.
