7. Solar Farm Proposal

It was agreed that plans would be available at the end of the APM if anybody wanted to look at them. There had been some confusion over whether the Solar Farm was on the APM agenda: it is not and will not be. The Chair has included it in his report and there will be an opportunity to raise it under any other business.

Some of the plans and documents were missing from the original application.

The Action Group, campaigners against the proposal, wanted to know if the Parish Council was still interested in their issues as it is very important to them.

The Chair had received correspondence from the land owner, James Harrison, and a response from Green Energy UK to the issues raised by the Action Group.

Any community benefit should not be a reason to support the application but the PC is duty bound to ensure that any community benefit will be payable in the event of permission being granted. There is now a new offer of £1,000 per megawatt. £50,000 available up front and the remainder being index linked, which over 25 years could make in excess of £250,000 available to the community.

This funding would not be subject to a 106 agreement but James' recent correspondence explained the agreement and the need to liaise with Green Energy. Green Energy had also been advised about the need to liaise with the Chair of the Parish Council. If the development of the site was sold on would the new owners renege on the agreement?

The Chair would say something before the APM regarding the untidiness and damage caused to property by signs being put up around the village, some to "Save Percy" (the peacock) and others "Say No to Solar Farm".

Cllr Forbes advised that she was simply representing the views of the Action Group to the Parish Council.

Cllr Dashwood was now custodian of the plans.
